

## **Alleghany County Water District (ACWD) Policies & Procedures**

### **Policy #300 Alleghany County Water District Conflict of Interest Code**

The Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 81000, et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code. It can be incorporated by reference and may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are here/by incorporated by reference along with the disclosure categories as set forth below, which constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the Alleghany County Water District.

Each action taken by a Board member and/or employee in the course of their duties will be motivated by the District's best interests and will be free of outside influence and self interests. In addition, board members shall not in any way directly or indirectly financially benefit from any aspect of the district's operations.

In accordance with this policy, Board and employees shall comply with the following:

1. Board members must abstain from voting on any action in which they have a financial interest.
2. No board member shall accept any remuneration in money or services from the district, except as allowed for by Government Code Section 30507.
3. All persons listed in category 1 of the Alleghany County Water District conflict of interest code shall file a Statement of Economic Interests, Form 700 annually by April 1<sup>st</sup> with the Clerk of the County of Sierra who shall retain copies and make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction. (Gov. Code section 81008).

**Category 1** shall disclose all information as required on Form 700: Alleghany County Water District Board of Directors, Officers and Managers.
